

Alternanthera pungens

Common name:

Khaki weed

Palatability to Livestock:

Low, when young.

Toxicity to Goats:

No.

Toxicity to Other Species:

May cause skin problems in cattle.

Poisonous Principle:

Unknown.

Effects:

Signs and symptoms;

- . Skin problems in cattle.
- . Can cause dermatitis, hay fever and asthma in humans.

Health and Production Problems;

- . Mechanical damage to feet and mouths of stock, and dogs.

Treatment;

Be aware of livestock problems.

Integrated Control Strategy:

- . Declared weed in Victoria, South Australia, and parts of NSW.
- . Deep cultivation to 15 cms or more to bury the seed.
- . Spot spray with herbicide on actively growing plants. Try hormone type, eg metsulfuron or glyphosates herbicides.
- . Hand pull small plants when soil is moist, making sure the taproot is removed.
- . Fertilise to assist competitive species.

Comments:

- . A low creeping perennial herb with a deep taproot.
- . Reddish, hairy, trailing stems which take root at the nodes, forming thick mats on the ground.

- . Leaves are opposite, light green and oval, upper leaves are smooth, lower surfaces are rough.
- . Flowers are prickly and burr-like, cream coloured, forming clusters in the leaf axils.
- . The flowers and burrs give the khaki colour to the plant.
- . Fruit is a small nut, amongst the flowers.
- . Reproduces by seed, transported by animals, tyres, and shoes etc.
- . Can grow all year round, but usually dies off in winter and grows in the warmer months.
- . Widespread in summer rainfall areas in NSW, but mainly in localized clusters.
- . A native of tropical America.
- . Occurs on stock routes and waste land, and is a nuisance in orchards.
- . Will spread in dense mats that prevent other pasture growth.
